

STARTING OF PG COURSES: ANOTHER LANDMARK ACHIEVEMENT IN THE PATH OF PROGRESS OF BPS GOVT. MEDICAL COLLEGE FOR WOMEN KHANPUR KALAN (SONEPAT)

Continuing its remarkable journey, on its Path of progress the Role Model institute of the state of Haryana, is enthralled to inform that LOP for 24 Post Graduate seats, in 7 Departments of Pre and Para Clinical subjects, has been issued to the institute vide Public notice released by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, New Delhi ,dated 27/1/16. This feat has been accomplished after facing an intense PG inspection in the month of August 2015. The distribution of seats Department wise is as under-

After availing the required NOC and the Essentiality Certificate from the Govt. of Haryana and the University of Health Sciences, Rohtak respectively, the institute applied to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare for PG seats in a total of 08 Departments along with the DD of Rs. 2 lacs per department. Out of these 08 departments, 07 departments have got the permission to start the PG courses from this year itself. This is a big achievement for the institute not only because its status will be upgraded to a Post- Graduate College, but also because there will be a tremendous upgrading of the already excellent quality services being provided by the institute in terms of patient care, teaching and research. It is pertinent to mention here that the college is yet to face the final inspection for the recognition of MBBS (UG) course, next year. This fact

makes this achievement much more commendable as PG seats have been sanctioned before the recognition of the institute. Most of the medical colleges of the state and neighbouring areas, although running recognised MBBS courses since many years, have got lesser number of PG seats sanctioned as is evident from Public Notice. This has been possible because the institute fulfils all the criteria of infrastructure, machinery and equipments, clinical material and staff.
